Fee Breakdown



Caloundra FC has separated the fees for 2018, we have reduced the club fees and absorbed the fee increase from Football Queensland and Sunshine Coast Football.

The uniform fee is extra, which is designed to cover the cost of brand new uniforms for all players.

Under 6 to 11s will receive a playing shirt, shorts and socks and a training top.

The Under 12s up will receive a Home and an Away playing kit, as well as training top, polo shirt and jacket.

The SAP players pay a higher fee as it includes all uniforms as well as coaching for 3 sessions per week!!

All uniform costs are reduced thanks to the generosity of our Club Sponsors!!

Online Registration Process

1. Head to www.playfootball.com.au and click on register now!
2. You will then be given 3 options. 1/ Proceed with your FFA Number if you can remember it! 2/ Find your FFA Number or 3/ Create an FFA account if you have never been registered before!
3. Once you have followed the prompts and have your FFA number and password you are ready to register!

REGISTRATION PROCESS

1. Now your logged in, select register.
2. Update your contact details if necessary.
3. Once you have clicked next enter Caloundra Football Club in the first box. In the next box select Player registration.
4. Make sure you **add the uniform option.**
5. Once you have the correct package added click the next button at the bottom of the screen.
6. Read and acknowledge the terms and conditions then click next.
7. Click on Pay Now to pay online with a credit card (VISA or MasterCard), or select 'Manual Payment at Club' if you want to pay at our sign on days/nights or via a bank transfer.

Trial Process
